

Operator's Manual

QUICK-FILL-ADAPTER



This manual is an attachment to the manual of your STEYR air rifle and should be read carefully before using the quick-fill-adapter.

The STEYR SPORT Quick fill adapter is delivered with a filling adapter with 1/8" thread.

Only use clean, dry and filtered compressed air preferably from a scuba tank. Each compressed air cylinder of STEYR SPORT is to be charged with a maximum filling pressure of 200 bar. Overpressure may damage the cylinder.

Before filling the compressed air cylinder with the Quick fill adapter, always ensure that the weapon is unloaded, the rifle is is cocked or (at LGB1 and Hunting 5) the magazine is removed. Remove the dust plug and insert the filling adaptor into the filling port until it stops.

Make sure the bleed screw on the charging unit is closed, and then open the air bottle valve slowly. (You can fill your compressed air cylinder also with a hand pump or a compressor) Fill the compressed air cylinder to the maximum recommended charge pressure slowly and close the valve.

Quickly open the air bleed valve on the charging unit to allow the pressurised air in the hose to escape. Remove the filling adaptor from the filling port.

Your weapon is cocked, you should de-cock it for safety rea-

sons. To de-cock your weapon, pull back the cocking lever and while holding the cocking lever, pull the trigger and close the cocking lever.

Guarantee Clauses: If within two years froth the day of purchase any cracks or breaks shouldIf within two years from the day of purchase any cracks or breaks should occur on this weapon that are due to material failure we undertake repair the defective parts free of charge (except O-rings).

Guarantee will be given by either replacing or repairing the weapon or parts of it at our sole discretion. The guarantee is only valid if the fully completed guarantee card is returned immediately after purchasing the weapon.

No guarantee claims will be accepted by the STEYR SPORT GmbH if:

- a) the weapon has been damaged or destroyed by force majeure or environmental influences;
- b) in case of damages/defects having been caused by improper treatment, or handling or by lack of care.
- c) if the weapon has been repaired, machined or altered by any person or workshop other than an authorised STEYR SPORT GmbH workshop.
